Mayor Jenkins opened the regular meeting of the Gaylord City Council with prayer by Council Member Wambold at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, July 25, 2011, in the City Council Chambers, located in the Gaylord City Hall, 305 East Main Street, Gaylord, Michigan. The Pledge of Allegiance followed the invocation.

Members Present: Campbell, Duczkowski, Jenkins, Johnson, Mankowski, Sharrard and Wambold.  
Members Absent: None.

Motion by Campbell, supported by Duczkowski, to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and to accept them as presented.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

During Public Comment Marie Kirt mentioned that she felt there was a "gap" in entertainment during Alpenfest, as there was no entertainment preceding larger performances.

Motion by Mankowski, supported by Campbell, to support the submission of an MDOT Safety Application to help fund the construction of Mankowski Road from its current termination point to the Home Depot parking lot. If approved, the project would be scheduled for 2013.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Duczkowski, supported by Johnson, Whereas, it is determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Gaylord to appoint a person who has expressed interest in serving as a member of the Downtown Development Authority (DDA), therefore by this action confirms the Mayor's appointment of Janet Nowicki to fill the vacancy on the DDA created by the resignation of Richard Hoyner.

Ayes: Campbell, Duczkowski, Jenkins, Johnson and Sharrard.  
Nays: Mankowski and Wambold. Abstained: Jenkins.

Motion failed due to lack of unanimous vote.
