Mayor Jenkins opened the regular meeting of the Gaylord City Council with prayer by Council Member Sharrard at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, March 26, 2012, in the City Council Chambers, located in the Gaylord City Hall, 305 East Main Street, Gaylord, Michigan. The Pledge of Allegiance followed the invocation.

Members Present: Campbell, Jenkins, Johnson, Mankowski, Sharrard and Wishart.

Members Absent: Duczkowski.

Motion by Sharrard, supported by Wishart, to amend the agenda for the meeting by adding the following under New Business:

- Charitable Solicitation Permit Request
- Consideration of Spring Clean-Up Proposal

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Wishart, supported by Campbell, to excuse Council Member Duczkowski from the meeting.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Mayor Jenkins opened the public hearing to receive public comment on the completed 2011 DDA Pavilion on Court Improvement Project. The Public Hearing was held as part of the close out of a Community Development Block Grant received by the City to fund this project. City Manager Duff described the scope of the project, the source and amount of funds expended. Marie Kirt asked for clarification on the percentage funded by grant and where the balance came from. Duff reconfirmed the amounts and source of local funding as coming from the DDA.

A Street Committee Meeting was scheduled for 10:30 a.m. Thursday, March 29.

Motion by Mankowski, supported by Campbell, to proclaim March 26, 2012 as "Arbor Day" and the month of March 2012 as "Professional Social Work Month".

Motion by Johnson, supported by Campbell, to approve a request by Angelica Rinehart for a Charitable Solicitation Permit to hold a bake sale on March 31st and April 1st to raise funds for the Otsego County Animal Shelter.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Mankowski, supported by Campbell, to accept the proposal for Spring Cleanup on May 12th from American Waste in the amount of \$65.25 per compacted cubic yard.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.
