Motion by Campbell, supported by Wishart, to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting and to accept them as presented.

During the Public Comment portion of the meeting Tammy LaBouef of 333 Felshaw Street questioned the validity of comments made by City Manager Joseph Duff at the August 12, 2013 City Council meeting as it related to the employee purchase of service years for retirement purposes and expense to the City.

City Manager Joseph Duff asked the Future Planning Committee to schedule a meeting for the following week.

Motion by Wishart, supported by Campbell, to award the bid for heating and cooling improvements at the Wastewater Treatment Plant to Climate Engineering of Gaylord, Michigan. Climate's bid of \$6,580 was the lowest received.
