

RESOLUTION
ESTABLISHMENT OF A MARIHUANA AD HOC COMMITTEE
RESOLUTION NO. 2020-3

WHEREAS, the Gaylord City Council has passed an Ordinance “opting out” of all five (5) types of recreational marihuana businesses in the City; and,

WHEREAS, the Gaylord City Council has seen an interest in the community in permitting the growing, processing and retail sales of marihuana by current property owners; and,

WHEREAS, the Gaylord City Council will establish a Marihuana Ad Hoc Committee made up of three (3) council members and six (6) members of the community; and

WHEREAS, the Marihuana Ad Hoc Committee will hold open meetings to discuss the merits of permitting marihuana operations within the City and make recommendations to the Gaylord City Council.

WHEREAS, the Gaylord City Council did, pursuant to its Charter, consider applications to fill the vacancies on the committee at its regular meeting on March 9, 2020, and by majority vote made the appointments set forth in this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Gaylord City Council appoints Mayor Wishart and Council Members Akin and Witt to serve on the committee, together with Tiffany Larson, Mark Hansen, Paul Gunderson, Katie Lynn Kucharek, Casey Buckleitner, and Steven Wisniewski.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall consider the merits of permitting marihuana activities within the City of Gaylord and make recommendations to City Council as set forth above. The meeting dates and procedures shall be established by the committee members.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee shall dissolve automatically at the earlier of one year following this resolution, or upon its final recommendations to the City Council, whichever occurs first, unless extended by the Gaylord City Council.
