October 14, 2019

Mayor Jenkins opened the regular meeting of the Gaylord City Council with a prayer by Council Member Wishart at 7:00pm on Monday October 14th, 2019, in the City Council Chambers, located in the Gaylord City Hall, 305 East Main Street, Gaylord, Michigan. The Pledge of Allegiance followed the invocation.

Members Present: Wishart, Jenkins, Ouellette, Sharrard, Hartz, and Witt.

Members Absent: Johnson.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the September 23rd, 2019 meeting and accept them as presented.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Wishart, supported by Hartz to excuse Council Member Johnson from tonight's meeting.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Rob Pallarito, Otsego County Commissioner, let the council and public know about the celebration for the 100<sup>th</sup> year of the Pigeon River County to be held on October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 3pm. It will also honor the 45<sup>th</sup> year of the Advisory Council for the Pigeon River Country.

Ken Mattei, Chairperson for the Gaylord Area Chamber of Commerce, let the council and public know that Taylar Akin is no longer the Executive Director of the Chamber and it will be 6 to 8 weeks before the new person is hired and begins employment. Ken Mattei and Cal McNamara will oversee the Chamber of Commerce until the new hire is in place.

Mark Hansen, 615 West Sheldon, asked if there was anything being done about the salvage yard that was accumulating at 512 West Sheldon Street. The City Police have been to the residence and the vehicles meet the ordinance requirements of being either registered or running. City Attorney Slough will send a letter to the land owner to try and get items cleaned up.

Motion by Sharrard, supported by Hartz to appoint Council Member Vic Ouellette as the City Council representative on the SANE Committee.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Witt, supported by Sharrard to approve the usage of Gornick Avenue and Wisconsin Avenue for the Turkey Trot on November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019 with the contingency that the City of Gaylord is added as an additional insured to their insurance coverage.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Hartz, supported by Ouellette to approve the sale of 403 North Hazel Avenue subjected to the allowance of higher offers to be received during the 30 day right of referendum period.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Wishart, supported by Hartz to enter into a purchase agreement with Powerhome Solar for Electric Vehicle Charging Stations to be placed in the City Parking Lot at the corner of South Court and First Street; with the contingency that \$70,000 will be received from Consumers Energy and \$10,000 will be received from the Michigan Energy Office.

The following Preamble and resolution were offered by Sharrard, supported by Wishart:

**WHEREAS,** the City of Gaylord has engaged in the MEDC Redevelopment Ready Communities Program, including entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the MEDC and undergoing an evaluation of the City's redevelopment practices as reported in the Redevelopment Ready Communities Baseline Report dated April 2019; and,

**WHEREAS,** the MEDC has developed a program for certifying Redevelopment Ready Communities and the City of Gaylord desires to achieve that certification by implementing best practices and recommended strategies for redevelopment; and,

**WHEREAS,** the City of Gaylord is in need of updating its Master Plan and will utilize recommendations and technical assistance to ensure that development readiness is appropriately addressed in this document; and,

**WHEREAS,** the program includes evaluating the strong partnerships with city boards and commissions related to development including the City Council, Planning Commission, and Downtown Development Authority; and,

**WHEREAS**, after review of the Redevelopment Ready Communities Baseline Report, the City of Gaylord is willing to complete the tasks as outlined, which will involve interaction with the aforementioned City Council and boards; and,

**WHEREAS,** certain recommendations have and will be made by the MEDC that are required in order for the City to attain Redevelopment Ready Communities Certification; therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED,** that the City of Gaylord, through its City Council authorizes the implementation of recommendations made by MEDC and that are necessary to receive Redevelopment Ready Communities Certification from MEDC.
