Mayor Wishart opened the regular meeting of the Gaylord City Council with a prayer by Council Member Awrey at 7:00pm on Monday October 12th, 2020, in the City Council Chambers, located in the Gaylord City Hall, 305 East Main Street, Gaylord, Michigan. The Pledge of Allegiance followed the invocation.

Members Present: Mayor Wishart, Sharrard, Witt, Hartz, Ouellette, Sides, and Awrey.

Members Absent: None.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Hartz to dispense with the reading of the minutes of October 12th, 2020 and accept them as presented.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt, to approve the recommendation of the future planning committee and instruct the City Attorney to respond to the purchase agreement submitted for 503 North Center Avenue. Attorney Slough will respond with an increased purchase price, the necessity of disclosing the intended use of the property, as well as changes to extended contingencies requested.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.

Motion by Sides, supported by Witt, to approve the recommendations of the future planning committee and not enter into any property sale agreements in the industrial park with marijuana related businesses that would have contingencies on the receipt of the necessary marijuana licenses. The restriction of property sales will be lifted if and when the city approves a recreational marijuana ordinance.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Sharrard to approve the MERS Defined Benefit Plan Adoption Agreement Addendums for Divisions 69030101, 69030102, 69030110 and 69030121 as well as the MERS Hybrid Plan Adoption Agreement Addendums for Divisions 690301HA and 690301HB.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion carried.
