The meeting was held in the City Council Chambers, located at City Hall, 305 East Main Street, Gaylord, Michigan.

Motion by Witt, supported by Wilson to dispense with the reading of the minutes from the April 11, 2022 meeting and accept them as presented.

**WHEREAS** the City of Gaylord in 2003 acquired title to Edelweiss Parkway and;

**WHEREAS** it is necessary to furnish certain information to the State of Michigan to place this street within the City Street System for the purpose of obtaining funds under Act 51, P.A. 1951 as amended.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED**, that the centerline of said street is described as:

ADD A PORTION OF EDELWEISS PARKWAY IN PART OF THE SOUTHEAST ¼ OF SECTION 5, T30N, R3W, CITY OF GAYLORD, OTSEGO COUNTY, MICHIGAN, WITH A CENTERLINE DESCRIBED AS COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 5; THENCE N01°06'00"W, 1315.18 FEET ALONG THE EAST

SECTION LINE; THENCE N89°56'28"W, 2269.97 FEET; THENCE N00°46'06"W, 66.02 FEET; THENCE N00°46'06"W, 768.32 FEET; THENCE S89°57'53"E, 540.52 FEET; THENCE N01°04'39"W, 153.64 FEET; THENCE 193.99' ALONG A CURVE TO THE RIGHT, SAID CURVE HAVING A RADIUS OF 300.00 FEET, A DELTA ANGLE OF 37°02'56", A LONG CHORD OF 190.63 FEET, BEARING N17°26'49"E; THENCE 179.24 FEET ALONG A CURVE TO THE LEFT, SAID CURVE HAVING A RADIUS OF 275.00 FEET, A DELTA ANGLE OF 37°20'38", A LONG CHORD OF 176.08 FEET, BEARING N17°17'58"E; THENCE N01°22'20"W, 231.94 FEET; THENCE 99.22 FEET ALONG A CURVE TO THE LEFT, SAID CURVE HAVING A RADIUS OF 275.00', A DELTA ANGLE OF 20°40'22", A LONG CHORD OF 98.68 FEET, BEARING N11°42'31"W; THENCE 11.45 FEET ALONG A CURVE TO THE RIGHT, SAID CURVE HAVING A RADIUS OF 300.00 FEET, A DELTA ANGLE OF 2°11'15", A LONG CHORD OF 11.45 FEET, BEARING N20°57'05"E TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE 220.28 FEET ALONG A CURVE TO THE RIGHT, SAID CURVE HAVING A RADIUS OF 300.00 FEET, A DELTA ANGLE OF 42°4'11", A LONG CHORD OF 215.36 FEET, BEARING N01°10'38"E; THENCE 106.61 FEET ALONG A CURVE TO THE LEFT, SAID CURVE HAVING A RADIUS OF 275.00 FEET, A DELTA ANGLE OF 22°12'44", A LONG CHORD OF 105.94 FEET, BEARING N11°06'22"E; THENCE N00°00'00"W, 47.4 FEET TO THE POINT OF END. SAID CENTERLINE HAVING AN OVERALL LENGTH OF 374.29 FEET.

That said street is located within a city right-of-way and is under the control of the City of Gaylord;

That said street is a public street and is for public street purposes;

That said street is accepted into the municipal street system and is open to the public for public use.
