The meeting was held in the City Council Chambers, located at City Hall, 305 East Main Street, Gaylord, Michigan.

Members Present: Sharrard, Hartz, Ouellette, Witt, Awrey, Ryan and Wilson.

Motion by Hartz, supported by Witt to dispense with the reading of the minutes from the July 11, 2022 meeting and accept them as presented.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion Carried.

Public Hearing: A public hearing regarding the Non-Use Variance at 615 W. Main Street opened at 7:01PM.

Comments were offered by C. Aiello and R. Thiery regarding the non-use variance.

The public hearing closed at 7:13PM.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Hartz to approve the Non-Use Variance Request at 615 W. Main Street.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Awrey to approve the Special Use Permit and Site Plan Review for 77 North (615 W. Main Street) with the following conditions/recommendations from the Planning Commission: (1) participate in the Knox Box program, (2) obtain a setback variance and (3) install motion lighting at rear entrance.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion Carried.

Motion by Wilson, supported by Awrey to approve the Outdoor Café Permit for Karma Taproom contingent upon providing the required site sketch/plan to the zoning administrator.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion Carried.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt to approve the State Trooper Outreach Program recognizing them as a non-profit.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion Carried.

Motion by Hartz, supported by Awrey to approve the Change Order (#1) for the Fifth Street Utility Improvements Project.

Ayes: Unanimous. Motion Carried.

No other business was presented and the meeting was adjourned at 7:40pm.
