

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on May 28, 2024 the Gaylord City Council announced by resolution its intent to set the special assessment for the special assessment district heretofore created for the purpose of defraying some of the cost of the operation and maintenance of the City Police and Fire Departments, in the amount of 4.00 mills of the taxable value of each parcel within the special assessment district and directing the preparation of the special assessment roll. The description of the special assessment district is as follows:

All real property within the geographic boundaries of the City of Gaylord and/or within the jurisdictional control of the City of Gaylord, including all properties that have come within the jurisdiction of the City of Gaylord through a contract pursuant to Public Act 425 of 1984, except property exempt from the collection of taxes under the General Property Tax Act.

The special assessment roll is available for inspection at the office of the City Clerk.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that a public hearing shall be held on June 10, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers, located in the Gaylord City Hall, 305 East Main Street, Gaylord, Michigan. The hearing shall be on the proposed amount of the special assessment, the estimated costs and expenses of police and fire protection, and on the proposed special assessment roll. At said time and place the City Council shall be in session to hear objections that may be offered to the cost estimate, the proposed amount of the special assessment, and/or the special assessment roll.
