

**CITY OF GAYLORD
ORDINANCE NO. 03-2024**

An ordinance to amend the City of Gaylord Sign Ordinance to clarify the timing for the display of political signs in the City of Gaylord.

THE CITY OF GAYLORD ORDAINS:

Section 1: Amendment of Section 2.

Section 2 titled "DEFINITIONS" is amended at subsection (38) titled "TEMPORARY AND PROMOTIONAL SIGNS", subsection (f)(3) to read as follows:

[replace previous Section 38(f)(3) (corrected to 38(i)(3)) in its entirety with:]

Political Signs shall not be installed more than forty-five (45) days before the first absentee ballots are mailed to voters containing the candidate or issue. Political Signs shall be removed within ten (10) days after the last election to which they pertain.

Section 2: Severability.

If any part of this Ordinance shall for any reason be finally adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance but shall be confined in its operation to the part directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment is rendered.

Section 3: Effective Date.

This amended ordinance shall be effective twenty (20) days after enactment or upon the date of publication, whichever date is later.
