Motion by Witt, supported by Jaques to not approve the Purchase Agreement for the City's 18 Acres. Council would like the Future Planning Committee to review and make a recommendation.

Motion by Ouellette, supported by Witt to approve the Partial Street Closure for the St. Patrick's Day Parade on March 15th at Noon. The parade will start at Michigan Avenue to Center Avenue, South on Center to 1st Street to the Pavillion.

Motion by Witt, supported by Wilson to approve the Backhoe Purchase from New Holland (Don's Tractor & Equipment Sales) in the amount of \$82,500.00
